Army Composition

Armies must be Battle-forged according to the Warhammer 40,000 Core Book and the Strike Force guidelines for 2000pts.

Army lists are to be submitted either using Battlescribe / Battleforge / New Recruit and submitted to Best Coast Pairing for review.

Rules to use:

When building your army, use all the the following publications from Games Workshop:

- Core Rules
- Army Codex Rules
- Munitorum Field Manual
- Index Datacards
- Mission Tactical Objective Deck
- FAQ and Errata Documents

Codex's must have an FAQ to be used. The cut off date for new rules from Games Workshop will be the 01/08/24. Any publications released after this date will not be considered.

Tools of War:

Attendees are expected to bring their army, **dice, a tape measure, a pen, paper, all relevant rules publications***, and **at least 3 physical copies of their army roster (one for each opponent, this can be digital)**.

*If you are using any electronic devices to carry your official rules references/army list, please ensure they are charged and available for reference at all times.

Extras:

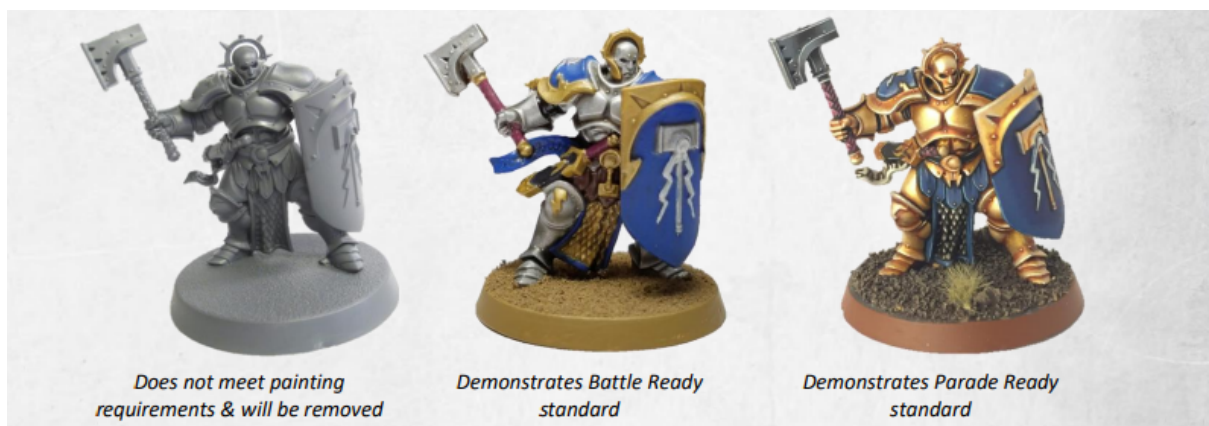
Players also need to bring these extra tools so that you have the resources to play some missions:

- 6 x Objective Markers on 40mm round base
- A set of Tactical mission datacards (if you have them)

If a player does not have a physical copy of the tactical mission cards, they will be required to run fixed missions. Digital card deck applications will not be allowed.

Painting

Your miniature collection is expected to be fully assembled and painted to at least a Battle Ready standard. Any player who has models removed will score 0 TP's for army painting.



Scoring

Scoring will be based on Win/Draw/Loss and ties will be differentiated by Victory points scored. All scores are to be submitted to Best Coast Pairings.

If you are mid-game when time is called, please keep scores from the end of the previous round. If you think you can "talk it out" for the current round, then score for that round as well. DO NOT score for subsequent rounds then your current one.

Missions

Missions will be predetermined for players and given to everyone at the beginning of each round. Players will be given the Map, Mission Rule and Primary Mission which will be universal across the round to ensure that points achievable stay universal. Players will only need to select Secondary Missions and Gambits.

Maps, Primary, and Mission rules will not be revealed until the start of each round, you must build a list that can be used in any mission/map combination.

Awards

Awards will be announced on the day, and will be subject to player numbers and support. Awards will be as follows:

- First
- Second
- Third
- Best Painted
- Wooden Spoon

List Submission

Lists will be due 1 week prior to the event, at 11:59pm on Friday 10th of August.
Lists must be submitted to Best Coast Pairings, late lists may be penalized.

Code of Conduct

Behaviour such as bullying, rules abuse, moving models illegally, picking up dice before your opponent has the chance to see the results, lying to judges or opponents, or any other form of unethical or inappropriate conduct can result in substantial in-game penalties, automatic losses being called, or removal from the event itself.

In the event of a rules dispute between players, contact the available event TO to resolve the dispute. TO decisions are final.

What you could lose points for:

- Being caught playing with an illegal list. Will result in losing points and may result in disqualification.
- Late scores - your scores may not be accepted if they are submitted more than 10 minutes after time is called. It takes time to process and check the draw before each round can start.
